St. Peter's Episcopal Church will host a 40 hour Hospitality and Service Industry Training Program to run April 24 – May 3, 2017.

This project will screen, orient, and train a select group of local candidates for hospitality positions for the 2017 season. Training modules will include:

- Introduction to the hospitality & service industry;
- basic and advanced customer service with role plays;
- developing the relationship with your employer;
- seasonal employment and life obstacles;
- personal financial management;
- application and resume training;
- reality based discussion of background checks and drug screening;
- interview scenarios and mock interviews.
