Is Your House Number Visible?



If an emergency responder needed to get to your house, could it be easily found? Street numbers of buildings should be at least 3 inches in height and displayed on the building in a manner that is plainly legible from the street at all times between sunrise and sunset. The color of the numbers should be in sharp contrast to the background. For houses far from the road or obstructed by trees a number should appear on both sides of the mailbox is helpful for anyone trying to locate your home.
