

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Jan. 15, to Sunday, Jan. 21, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD responded to 244 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Jan. 15

- **Lewiston Road/Mountain View Drive, assist public** – Officer initiated call. Patrol observed a disabled vehicle and stopped to assist. Driver had contacted AAA and was waiting on a tow truck.
- **3100 block of Park Avenue, Youngstown, overdose** – 911 call; patrols responded.
- **5100 block of Bridgeman Road, call unspecified** – Caller to 911 reported a vehicle had rear-ended a garbage truck. Patrols responded; no injuries or tows needed. Accident report completed.

Violations were: driver cited for passed red light and aggravated unlicensed operation for three of more open suspensions on at least three separate dates; driver, speed in zone; driver, aggravated unlicensed operation, second and violation unspecified.
