

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Tuesday, Sept. 24, to Monday, Sept. 30, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 375 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Tuesday, Sept. 24

- **900 block of Swann Road, alarm/burglary** – Alarm provider reported front and rear entry door alarms activated; officers responded.
- **Swann/Creek Roads, traffic complaint** – 911 call, a three-gallon gas container found in the roadway; patrol responded.
