

# Kearns to host fall 'DisAbility' awareness event

## County Clerk fosters awareness and accessibility with auto bureau outreach

 Erie County Clerk Michael P. Kearns and the Erie County Office for People with Disabilities will hold the semi-annual "DisAbility Awareness Day" from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 2, at the newly renovated Erie County Auto Bureau located in the Urban-dale Plaza, 2122 George Urban Blvd., Depew. No appointment is required for this community outreach event.

Individuals with disabilities and their families will be able to obtain state-issued picture identification through the Erie County Auto Bureau and be assisted with other matters pertaining to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

"October just wrapped up National Disability Employment Awareness Month," Kearns said. "We continue to assist those with disabilities obtain

government-issued identification so when an employment opportunity presents itself they are prepared with the required ID to accept the job. Inclusion matters for people with disabilities, and many face significant barriers when searching for a job. Not having proper identification will never be one of them here in Erie County."

The Erie County Office for People with Disabilities will also

be on hand to share information and provide a thorough understanding of how the county can assist with identifying opportunities and services available to all residents who are disabled and their family members. Those who need to coordinate a reasonable accommodation can contact the Erie County Office for People with Disabilities at 716-858-6215.

taining a driver's license, an enhanced license, REAL ID or a non-driver identification are required to bring the following documents as proof of identification: original or certified copy of birth certificate, and original Social Security card.
