

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Tuesday, Sept. 17, to Monday, Sept. 23, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 300 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Tuesday, Sept. 17

- **Garlow/Saunders Settlement roads, MVA-property damage** – 911 caller reported a two-vehicle accident. Patrol said vehicle No. 2 was stopped at a stop sign, turning right; vehicle No. 1 turned left and struck the driver's side of vehicle No. 2, then fled the scene. Driver later returned and spoke with patrol. Citations issued with date for Lewiston Town Court; report taken.
- **Lewiston/Military roads, check welfare** – Caller stated a male wearing all-black clothing was possibly hitchhiking; subject located by LPD. Male on foot due to no bus service; patrol said the male had difficulty walking and is always seeking a ride into village.
- **800 block of Center Street, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. Patrol stated a male was slumped over the wheel at a gas pump; subject awoken by officer. Male said he had been working and was tired; no signs of impairment found. Subject released to drive and advised to pull over to rest if needed.
- **LPD patrol activity** – Calls of officer initiated. Vehicle/traffic stops throughout the village and town for motor vehicle violations; 11 drivers cited with uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court. Patrols issued five warnings to other drivers for violations.

- **900 block of Center Street, MVA-property damage** – 911 caller reported a four-vehicle accident, vehicles unable to move from side of roadway. Patrols stated vehicle No. 1 rear-ended vehicle No. 2, resulting in a chain-reaction accident; vehicle No. 3 struck vehicle No. 4. Heavy front-end damage on vehicle No. 1 and air bag deployment; front-end damage to vehicles 2 and 3, with rear-end damage on vehicle No. 4. No injuries; all parties declined EMS. Vehicle No. 1 driver cited by patrols; uniform traffic ticket for Lewiston Town Court. Report taken.
- **LPD patrol activity** – Calls of officer initiated. Patrols issued two warnings to drivers for violations.
