

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Oct. 21, to Sunday, Oct. 27, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered 234 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Oct. 21

- **Cayuga/S. Eighth streets, accident hit-run** – 911 caller reported a grey SUV struck a vehicle and fled. Driver of vehicle No. 2 was at a business on Ninth/Cayuga streets and stated that vehicle No. 1 struck her vehicle twice while at a stop sign on Eighth Street and took off.
