

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Nov. 4, to Sunday, Nov. 11, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered 261 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Monday, Nov. 4**
- **5700 block of Military Road, check welfare** – Caller from New York Power Authority reported a male at the gate claiming to be lost. Officers responded.
  - **400 block of Plain Street, theft** – Officer initiated call. Patrol received a video report of a recent flowerpot theft at the address.
