

## GRAND ISLAND FIRE CO. CALL SUMMARY

The following Grand Island response activity occurred Thursday, Oct. 24, to Wednesday, Oct. 30, as reported by the Erie County Sheriff's Office. ECSCO deputies responded to 350 calls during the period of this report. During this time frame, deputies responded to seven business burglary alarms; five residential burglary alarms; two mental health calls; five welfare checks and handled several first aid calls.
