ERIE COUNTY SHERIFF’S OFFICE REPORT

The following Grand Island response activity occurred Thursday, Nov. 14, to Wednesday, Nov. 27, as reported by the Erie County Sheriff’s Office. ECSO deputies responded to 660 calls during the period of this report. During this time frame, deputies responded to four business burglary alarms; four residential burglary alarms; two mental health calls; 13 welfare checks; and handled several first aid calls.
