

The following activity occurred Thursday, Feb. 15, to Tuesday, Feb. 20, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD responded to more than 300 calls during this period. Thursday, Feb. 15

- **Ridge/Creek roads, animal complaint** – Caller reported unknown animal in roadway; driver had to swerve to avoid accident. Patrol checked area for the "mystery animal" with negative results.
