

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, March 4, to Sunday, March 11, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD responded to 308 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, March 4
