

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, April 8, to Sunday, April 14, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD responded to more than 342 calls during this period. Monday, April 8

- **4100 block of Lower River Road, suspicious activity** – 911 complaint; officer responded.
- **900 block of N. Hewitt Drive, check welfare** – Caller to 911 reported a female screaming. Responding patrols said the screaming noise was attributed to an animal in the area.
- **100 block of Center Street, traffic complaint/investigation** – Per dispatch activity, ongoing parking problems in a no parking zone. Patrol responded and issued four parking tickets.

- **5500 block of Walmore Road, harassment** – Caller reported that three subjects on ATVs drove through their backyard the previous night. Caller approached the subjects to advise them they were private property and said the subjects attacked him. Patrols responded and completed a report.
- **1600 block of Swann Road, fire** – Caller to 911 reported active flames in the bottom of an old silo and heavy black smoke in the area. Patrol reported a controlled bonfire; all OK.
