

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, April 15, to Sunday, April 21, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD responded to 269 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, April 15

- **3500 block of Ransomville Road, 911 hang-up** – Patrol on location; no further information.
- **19000 block of Mount Hope Road, MVA-property damage** – 911 caller said one vehicle went off the roadway and was now between trees. Patrols responded; report taken.
