

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Saturday, May 25, to Friday, May 31, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 300 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Saturday, May 25

- **2600 block of Saunders Settlement Road, assist public** – 911 caller was upset that his wife purchased an item for \$42 without realizing its cost, and later sought to return the item without success. Store manager told officers that all sales are final; caller advised.
- **Ridge/Dickersonville roads, traffic complaint** – Caller said a white mini-van with children in the back seat was driving recklessly. Patrol checked area with negative results.
- **Locations at Creek Road/Hillview Court and Lewiston/Military roads, vehicle/traffic stops** – Calls officer initiated. Both drivers cited for speed in zone; uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court. Patrols said nine warnings were issued to other drivers for motor vehicle violations. Report taken.

- **LPD patrols conducted multiple vehicle/traffic stops throughout the village and town for motor vehicle violations** – Six drivers were cited for violations with uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court. Patrols issued nine warnings to other drivers for motor vehicle violations.

- **Townline/Lower Mountain roads, MVA-injuries** – Patrols responded to a 911 call; no further information. Report taken. Patrols returned to the intersection later for a reported MVA-property-damage accident. Officers said one driver turned into the intersection too early, striking the second driver. Patrols issued two warnings to other drivers for motor vehicle violations.
