

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Tuesday, June 25, to Sunday, June 30, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 300 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Tuesday, June 25

- **500 block of Morgan Drive, suspicious activity** – 911 caller reported an unknown party banging on the front door. Subjects woke caller up who is now afraid to answer the door. Patrols responded and found kids were playing "ding-dong ditch." Call handled.
- **7500 block of Lewiston Road, MVA-injuries** – 911 caller reported a male fell off a dirt bike, subject bleeding from the face and unresponsive. Patrols said the operator was riding without a motorcycle helmet; driver attempted a burnout and lost control, was ejected and landed face first on the pavement. EMS and fire responders stabilized the driver who was transported via MercyFlight for injuries. Accident report completed.
- **900 block of Elliott Drive, ATL/BOLO** – Officers on location attempting to locate a subject wanted on criminal contempt charges for the Town of Tonawanda.
- **400 block of Cayuga Street, criminal investigation** – Caller

reported the ex was violating a full stay away order of protection via electronic messages. Officers responded; report taken.

- **1700 block of Upper Mountain Road assist** – Caller reported juveniles inside an abandoned residence; patrols searched the property with negative results.

### Wednesday, June 26

- **Portage Road/Artpark area, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot. Patrol located the male who said he was only taking photos of nearby buildings and the street on his phone. Patrol's check of the phone found no questionable materials; all OK. Patrol cleared.
