

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Thursday, Aug. 1, to Tuesday, Aug. 6, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 400 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Thursday, Aug. 1

- **Lewiston Road/Fort Gray Drive, assist** – Officer initiated call. Officers assisting cyclists down Lewiston hill.
