

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Wednesday, Aug. 7, to Sunday, Aug. 11, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 250 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Wednesday, Aug. 7**
- **800 block of Center Street, suspicious activity** – Call officer initiated. Patrols responded.
 - **300 block of Center street, assist public** – 911 caller requested patrol regarding ongoing issues with subjects staying at an Airbnb. Complainant reported partying until 4 a.m. and being harassed by visitors to the rental. Patrol advised caller to contact the Village of Lewiston for assistance, as the complaint is a civil matter.
 - **500 block of Mountain View Drive, traffic complaint** – 911 caller reported a gold Chevy Equinox driving at a high rate of speed. Caller said the driver deliberately sped by the residence and nearly hit walkers. Area checked by patrol with negative results.
 - **5900 block of Garlow Road, burglary** – 911 complaint; patrols responded; report taken.
 - **Lewiston Road/Mountain View Drive, assist public** – 911 caller reported a tire blow out; vehicle stuck in roadway creating a hazard. Patrol arranged for a vehicle tow and provided a courtesy ride to the family.
 - **1100 block of Elliott Drive, assist** – Caller requested patrol regarding an incident involving a teenage daughter. Patrols interviewed all parties; statement secured from juvenile. Information relayed to Niagara Falls Police Department

due to location of incident. Report taken.

- Thursday, Aug. 8**
- **100 block of Center Street, assist public** – 911 caller reported a boyfriend-girlfriend argument at a hotel business. Female wished to retrieve her luggage before a flight home the next morning. Patrols assisted on the property exchange without issue. Call cleared.
 - **Saunders Settlement/Walmore roads, MVA-injuries** – 911 caller reported a two-vehicle, T-bone accident with airbag deployment. Both drivers told responding patrols they had the green light; a witness confirmed said traffic signal was not operating. Vehicle No. 1 stuck a pole and the traffic light system housing before striking a pine tree. Both drivers evaluated on scene and vehicles towed. NITEC traffic agency notified; accident report completed.
 - **4000 block of Creek Road, LPD office, harassment** – Officer initiated call. Patrol took a walk-in complaint on a neighbor harassment incident. Report taken.
 - **James/Marywood drives, traffic complaint** – 911 caller reported a reckless driver in the neighborhood. Patrols located the vehicle; driver advised the vehicle was being repaired prior to inspection. Driver advised to keep vehicle off the road until registered.
 - **LPD patrol activity** – Calls officer initiated. Multiple vehicle/traffic stops throughout the village and town for motor vehicle violations; one driver cited with uniform traffic ticket issued for Lewiston Town Court. Patrols issued eight warnings to other drivers for violations.

- Friday, Aug. 9**
- **100 block of S. Fourth Street, assist public** – Caller said the property landlord

ordered a family member to leave the address for calling the police. Officers responded; landlord not on location. Patrol advised caller that the property landlord would have to physically present paperwork to begin the eviction process.

- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, warrant service** – Officer initiated call. One male detained on warrant execution.

- **500 block of Colt Avenue, disturbance non-domestic** – 911 caller reported an unknown subject pulled out a gun following a road rage incident. Patrols located and detained the driver. Subject found to have a baseball bat and no firearm. Caller did not wish to pursue charges at this time.

- **100 block of S. Fourth Street, suspicious activity** – 911 caller reported a camper trailer parked on the street for an hour. Officers responded.
 - **Lewiston/Military roads, 911 caller reported a road rage incident; driver in a convertible with a large teddy bear in the front seat** – Officers checked

the area with negative results.
