“We've got a really strong horticulture team in place. All of this landscaping is relatively new. ... It's gorgeous,” she said.

Castellani's 'Party on the Portico' celebrates art, music, conversation

The Castellani Art Museum of Niagara University welcomed members, friends, and the wider Western New York community to "Party on the Portico" on June 25. CAM's annual summer celebration was set against the backdrop of the museum's iconic portico and current summer exhibitions. It brought together art, music, conversation, and community in one of CAM's most anticipated annual traditions.

"Party on the Portico" featured live music by pianist Kevin Clark, light bites sponsored by the Niagara Falls Culinary Institute, and a series of plein air-style live art demonstrations by regional artists Kath Schifano, Doug Mess, John Sauter and Joel Mulindwa. Throughout the evening, visitors had the rare opportunity to watch each artist create an original work in real time, offering an intimate look into their unique artistic processes and creative approaches.

CAM Interim Director Michael

Beam updated the audience on museum happenings and funding initiatives. And, in keeping with CAM's ongoing lifetime membership initiative, the museum honored artist Schifano, whose work is represented in CAM's permanent collection. Schifano received a lifetime membership in recognition of her artistic contributions and lasting impact on the museum's collection and community.

"Party on the Portico" embodies everything that makes CAM special," Beam said prior to the event. "It brings together artists, members, students, and the community in a way that is accessible, engaging and inspiring. It's a celebration of the creative energy that continues to thrive throughout our region."

Current works on display inside the Castellani Art Museum include "The Family," an oil on canvas painting by William Y. Cooper (gift of the Diane Castellani and Terrance Bromley family); "Breathing Water: For Niagara, Thundering Waters" by Beili Liu, a mixed-media collection of ocean, river and lake plastics gathered from the shorelines of the Arctic Ocean, Barents Sea, Norwegian Sea, North Pacific Ocean, North Atlantic Ocean, Baltic Sea, North Sea, Adriatic Sea, Mediterranean Sea, Gulf of Mexico, Lake Ontario and the Niagara River; and "Earth" by Chantal Calato, which is discarded plastic toys, hand-painted cotton rope, and bolts.

Paraphrasing Castellani's note: "Earth" is one in a fleet of push toy monstrosities – gigantic push toys made from discarded toys lashed together with hand-painted cotton rope. The toys, collected from people's garbage heaps around the City of Buffalo, are anywhere from 40-plus years old to almost new – toys one might even have in their own backyard. They are engraved with play and dirt and scribbled with the children's names who once played with them. This work reflects Calato's commitment to environmental stewardship by rescuing these

'Pedal for Parks 2026' to roll again

Ride celebrates America 250 & beauty of NYS parks

The Niagara Region of the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation announced the third annual "Pedal for Parks," presented by the Maid of the Mist, in support of local New York state parks.

The noncompetitive, family-friendly ride will take place Sunday, Sept. 20, and will start at Fort Niagara State Park. There are three different routes with various lengths that will take riders through Artpark, Joseph Davis, Fort Niagara, Four Mile Creek, Wilson Tuscarora, Devil's Hole,

Whirlpool and Niagara Falls state parks. The 100-kilometer ride goes to Golden Hill State Park.

The routes for the ride will show off millions of dollars in recent investments made by New York State Parks in partnership with the Niagara River Greenway, the New York Power Authority, the New York State Department of Transportation and the Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Foundation in the local trail system. All proceeds will stay in Western New York and support programming in the parks.

a police report, the saw was returned to the complainant.

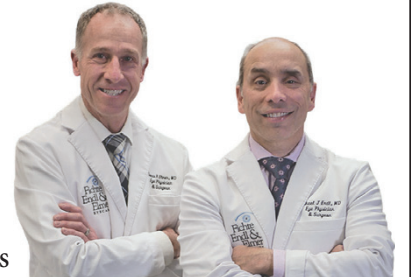
Wednesday, June 10

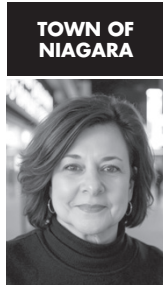
Town of Niagara:

Understanding the move to a single tax rate

The Town of Niagara is taking steps to eliminate its current two-tier property tax system and replace it with a single tax rate for both residential and business property owners. This change follows the town's comprehensive reassessment, which brought properties to full and fair assessed value, including commercial properties throughout the town.

The Town Board unanimously approved a new local law to rescind the existing homestead and non-homestead rate structure. The law would take effect when the town certifies its assessment roll on July 1.

Following last year's reassessment, the dif-

ference between the total taxable values for homestead and non-homestead properties was reduced to a minimal amount. That made it possible for the town to move toward one uniform tax rate. Although there was not enough time last year to complete the required process, including a public hearing, the Town Board chose to move forward this year in anticipation that the assessments would remain at 100% and support the transition to a single rate.

The Town of Niagara is currently the only town in Niagara County that still uses a two-tier tax rate system, aside from the City of Niagara Falls. Moving to a single rate will bring the town more in line with the rest of Niagara County's municipalities.

I am also sharing the tax rates for munic-

palties across Niagara County, so taxpayers can better understand the differences among communities – including which municipalities are assessed at 100%; which have different tax rates; and which pay a separate refuse rate.

At this time, Town of Niagara residents do not pay a refuse tax, and our county tax rate remains among the lowest. However, as long as Republic Services remains open, the town will not need to levy a refuse tax. With Republic's eventual closure approaching, it is important for residents to understand that a refuse tax will likely become necessary in the future.

Dive into safety: Summer pool tips for everyone

After a long winter, Western and Central New Yorkers are welcoming summer. Unfortunately, every year in the U.S., there are an estimated 4,500 unintentional drownings, according to the Centers for Disease Control, which reports 4,500 deaths due to drowning each year from 2020-22, 500 more per year compared to 2019. Drowning is also one of the leading causes of unintentional death in children between the ages of 1 and 9, while children ages 1-4 have the highest drowning rates. Most childhood drownings occur in swimming pools, even under supervision.

"When warmer weather arrives, many people look to cool off in the pool, but safety should always come first," said David Kirst, insurance manager at AAA Western and Central New York. • Use a safety cover when your pool is not in use. Pool covers should tightly cover the entire pool so children or pets cannot

• Keep lifesaving equipment nearby. Life rings, floats or a reaching pole should be easily accessible.

Learn and teach water safety skills

• Supervise children at all times. Have inexperienced swimmers swim stay with an adult in the pool and wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved vest.

• Limit alcohol use. The CDC reports that alcohol is involved in 70% of all teen and adult deaths as-

sociated with water recreation.

• Regularly check the pool area for any potential accident hazards.

• Don't leave toys or floats in the pool when not in use. Kids may fall into the pool trying to reach them.

• Take CPR and first aid training or refresh your training. Those trainings save lives every year.

Momming as a Millennial:

Raising emotionally safe kids starts with our words

"You're overreacting." "You're so dramatic." "Crying isn't going to change anything."

Most of us have probably heard one of those phrases at some point growing up. Maybe they came from a parent, grandparent or another well-meaning adult who believed they were helping us become tougher.

I know I did. I grew up in a family where emotions weren't something you talked about. At best, my feelings were dismissed. At worst, they were ridiculed and mocked. From a very young age, I learned that having emotions was a problem – and showing them was even worse.

Whenever I expressed big feelings, I was often told I was being dramatic or overreacting. My mom even nicknamed me "Gloria Swanson," referencing an old Hollywood actress she described as overly dramatic. I didn't understand the reference as a child, but I understood the message loud and clear.

My feelings were too much. So as I got older, I stopped sharing them.

Like many millennials, I've spent much of adulthood untangling the messages I absorbed as a child. I became a people pleaser. I avoided conflict. I questioned my own instincts. **Looking back, I can see that years of having my emotions dismissed taught me something I never should have learned: that my feelings couldn't be trusted.**



Then I became a mom.

One day, my son was having a tantrum when someone casually laughed and said, "He's got his mother's dramatics."

Later, I heard my daughter being called "the next Gloria Swanson."

It stopped me in my tracks. Because I know firsthand what labels like that can do.

Children don't hear those comments as harmless jokes. They hear them as truths about who they are.

When we repeatedly tell children they're dramatic, sensitive, difficult or emotional, they don't learn how to regulate their feelings. They learn that having feelings is the problem.

And the research backs this up. Psychologists call it emotional invalidation: dismissing, minimizing

or criticizing someone's emotional experience. Over time, children who regularly experience emotional invalidation may become less confident expressing themselves, have greater difficulty regulating emotions, and may even begin doubting their own experiences.

I've experienced these things firsthand. When I'm working through a situation in therapy, my instinct is to dismiss my own feelings. It's as if there is a reflex deep within me that immediately doubts my feelings as real or valid.

Knowing what I know now, I'm intentionally trying to break that cycle with my own children. Our home has plenty of tears, frustration and big feelings, but my goal isn't to stop those emotions. It's to help my children learn what to do with them.

Berti pointed out how, around the world, "People save money their whole lives to come here."

And while those individuals will have to pay for transportation, lodging and meals, amongst other things, "You could come in here, walk around for free, spend an entire day and not spend a dime," Berti said.

Here are some popular and affordable options:

What to do

•**Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Welcome Center at Niagara Falls State Park, FREE**

The Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Welcome Center at Niagara Falls State Park opened in 2023 and serves as an ideal starting point for guests. This \$46 million, 28,000-square-foot venue has ticket and information stations; memorabilia that includes a piece of daredevil Nik Wallenda's 2012 cross-border wire-walk "rope"; a gift shop with Niagara Falls swag, and a concession area that serves DiCamillo Bakery pizza and biscotti, Fowler's chocolates and sponge candy, and even Dippin' Dots ice cream.

Earlier this month, two new attractions opened inside the welcome center.

•**"Voices of the Falls," FREE**

The \$4.4 million permanent, interactive exhibit explores the past, present and future of Niagara Falls – the park as well as the surrounding community – in the voices of those who have been part of its history. Featuring first-person perspectives, historical narratives, artifacts, hands-on interactive and video presentations, the nearly 5,000-square-foot exhibit highlights the cultural, environmental and personal connections that have formed the nation's oldest state park.

Stories from the Indigenous who first inhabited the land to the Underground Railroad to the tragedy of Love Canal as well as the flora and fauna of the park are included and will provide visitors with a richer view of the park beyond the waterfall. Additional elements of the project include outdoor models, a lenticular mural and signage.

Berti said, "We in Niagara Falls worked very, very closely" with the community on this exhibit. "When we did the content for this, we created a coreaction group, and it was Tuscarora and Seneca; and we met every single week for two to three years, where they told the stories;

they put the stories together. We said, "What do you want the world to know?" So, what you see is in their words, their stories, instead of us trying to do that."

Callouts to Old Fort Niagara and the Castellani Art Museum encourage guests to extend their stay and discover more Niagara Region history.

Berti said the creative team sought first-person accounts for the welcome center attraction so that it's "more meaningful. It tells a better story."

•**"Above the Roar," \$18**

State Parks' licensed concession partner, Delaware North, teamed with award-winning experiential design and media production firm MDSX on "Above the Roar," a 4-minute ride providing an incredible look at the falls. The fully immersive, multisensory virtual reality (VR) experience takes participants on a thrilling journey around the most powerful waterfall in North America.

Through exclusive aerial footage, motion-enhanced seating and immersive sound, participants soar along the U.S. side of the Niagara River just above the rapids and then over the American, Bridal Veil

and Horseshoe falls before gliding through the gorge and plunging into the depths below. There, under the water, encounter seven species of fish that are native to the river before returning to the brink of the American Falls and ending back inside the welcome center.

The room that houses the VR ride is tricked out with lights and music to further enhance the experience. A moving chair serves as a vehicle for the adventure.

Delaware North's Niagara Falls general manager, Michael Barnes, said, "The park has two iconic attractions – has for years – and they're different experiences (Cave of the Winds, Maid of the Mist). I challenged these guys for something that's not like those experiences – and that's what that is. It takes you where you can't go."

Indeed, even those who frequent Niagara Falls State Park haven't seen it from this vantage point.

But the ride is more than just thrilling.

"It's subtle, but the script in there goes through a lot of the history and the information on the falls," Barnes said.

•**Welcome center plaza, FREE**
Outside of the welcome center

plaza, there is a wayfinding map that points out attractions both in Niagara Falls State Park and the City of Niagara Falls.

On the outside of a dedicated restroom building, guests can take a picture in front of a lenticular mural.

Native American art and history lines the periphery, and a reconfigured staircase doubles as a beautiful gateway to the water.

The courtyard will host music and special events throughout the summer.

•**Niagara Regional Archive, FREE**

Last summer, State Parks announced the 7,000-square-foot former regional administration building was transformed into the Niagara Regional Archive and multipurpose community room.

Headed up by Curator Courtney Geerhart, the building provides a rare opportunity to explore remarkable and special pieces of Niagara Falls' history.

"Niagara Falls is really unique," Geerhart said. "I always say there's something new to learn in Niagara Falls. So, if you haven't been to the area in a while, if you haven't been

to the falls, this is a great time of year to come out, come visit and see it, experience it for the first time anew."

She added, "People are welcome to come in for research appointments. If they're interested in coming in and doing research or learning more and going through these documents, we are open for public research appointments. Locals are welcome to do that, if the exhibit's not their thing or if they want to learn more and do more with us."

To make an appointment, email Courtney.Geerhart@parks.ny.gov (include "Research Request" in the subject line).

Lobby displays change each year and highlight a particular theme. In 2025, it was the 140th anniversary of Niagara Falls becoming a state park. This summer, the pieces on display are tied to "Power & Revolution: The History of Power in Niagara."

Geerhart said it's "the idea of the history of power in Niagara Falls, specifically, and how that affected the falls, the park. The dichotomy of preservation versus the power industry, and how there was kind of a clash at times, but also worked together to provide power for the community."

Berti emphasized the historic value of Niagara Falls State Park: "This is more than just water falling over rocks. We say it over at the Cave of the Winds: The world changed here. ... That is fact. A lot happened here. There would be no public parks if it weren't for this place."

She added, "People come from all over. They write about it. They paint it. They photograph it. And it's in our backyard."

•Crow's nest, FREE

One of the most unique views of Niagara Falls will come from the area near the Prospect Point park observation tower. State Parks is overseeing creation of a new crow's nest – and targeting a late-August reopening

"It's coming along. It's going to be, I would say, on par with Cave of the Winds in terms of access to the falls," Berti said. For the people walking right alongside the water, "It's an amazing view."

The existing platform area isn't optimized for viewing (let alone picture-taking). When finished, the new and improved crow's nest will connect the overlook with the area near where guests board the Maid of the Mist. During peak season, this elevator alternative also will help with moving people out of the attraction area. In the shoulder months, it will be a two-way staircase.

•More affordable than you think

Of course, there is a fee to take part in Niagara Falls State Park's two most iconic attractions – but the price is less than two movie tickets ... or leaving a vehicle in downtown Buffalo on event nights.

✓ The **Cave of the Winds** ticket price fluctuates depending on time of the year, with adult passes ranging from \$14 to \$23. Youth entry starts at \$10 and increases to \$19. State Parks is offering a new "Cave & Save" promotion wherein Cave-goers can save on admission tickets to the Aquarium of Niagara, Old Fort Niagara, Rainbow Air Helicopter Tours & Niagara Virtual Experience, and Frank Lloyd Wright's Martin House.

✓ The **Maid of the Mist** ticket is just \$30.25 for adults (\$19.75 for youth ages 6-12) and includes a souvenir rain poncho. A favorite for celebrities, athletes and dignitaries for more than 100 years, the tour boat "ferries past the base of the American Falls, and onto the basin of Horseshoe Falls – the dramatic passage leading you through the roiling waterfall whitewater and massive rock formations," the Niagara Falls State Park website notes. "The Maid of the Mist returns guests to shore with newfound appreciation of the power and grandeur of Niagara Falls."

For years, a sticking point for locals interested in exploring Niagara Falls has been the price to park – but it's actually only \$10 on Goat Island.

Serious injury motor vehicle accident in Porter

On Monday, June 29, at approximately 10:11 a.m., the Niagara County Communications Center received a report of a serious personal injury motor vehicle accident in front of 1678 Braley Road in the Town of Porter. Initial responding patrol units confirmed the crash involved a dirt bike.

The operator of the dirt bike, 20-year-old Kayden Smith of Youngstown, was found unconscious and suffering from serious injuries. Deputies and EMS personnel immediately began providing emergency medical care at the scene. Smith was transported by Mercy Flight to the Erie County Medical Center with life-threatening injuries. She continues to recover.

The operator of the pickup truck involved in the crash was treated at the scene for minor injuries.

The preliminary investigation indicates the dirt bike attempted to enter Braley Road through a tree line and pulled into the path of a westbound pickup truck traveling on Braley Road.

The crash remains under investigation by the Niagara County Sheriff's Office accident investigation unit (AIU).

That's where emotional validation comes in. And if you're anything like me, you may have wondered: "If I comfort my child during a tantrum, am I rewarding the behavior?"

Here's what I've learned: Validation doesn't mean giving in. You can acknowledge what they're feeling while still holding firm boundaries.

So, what does emotional validation actually look like?

These are a few of the practices I'm working on as I learn to become a better active listener for my children. I'm certainly not perfect, but they've helped me slow down and respond differently when emotions run high.

•**Be fully present.** I try to put down my phone, make eye contact and give my child my full attention. Sometimes the greatest gift I can offer isn't advice. It's my presence.

•**Listen before I solve.** My mama bear instinct is to jump straight into problem-solving. But I'm learning that my children don't always need solutions right away. Sometimes they simply need someone to hear them. Instead of offering advice immediately, I try asking, "Can you tell me more about what happened?" or "What was the hardest part?"

•**Name the emotion I see.** My children don't always have the words to describe what they're feeling, so I'm trying to help them put words to those big emotions. Instead of assuming or brushing it off, I might say, "It sounds like you're feeling really frustrated," or "I wonder if you're disappointed because things didn't go the way you hoped." By naming the emotion, I hope they'll eventually learn to recognize and express it themselves.

•**Reflect before I redirect.** This one has been a game-changer for me. I'm learning that I don't have to agree with my child's reaction to acknowledge it. Before I correct the behavior or jump into consequences, I try to say something like, "That sounds really hard," or "I can understand why you feel that way." I want my children to know their emotions are valid, even when their behavior needs guidance.

•**Ask what they need.** As my children get older, I want them to know they don't have to navigate hard feelings alone. Sometimes

before offering advice, I try to ask, "Do you want me to just listen, or would you like help figuring out what to do next?" I'm hoping it will help them identify the kind of support they're looking for while reminding them they're not alone.

None of this excuses behavior or removes consequences. But it does communicate something essential: "Your feelings are safe with me." And when kids feel emotionally safe, they don't just come to us in the easy moments – they come to us in the hard ones, too.

This kind of parenting didn't come naturally to me. It wasn't what I grew up with. And I don't always get it right.

There are still moments when I slip into old patterns or feel my frustration rise before I can catch it. But I've learned that parenting isn't about being perfect. It just requires awareness and a willingness to keep trying.

I think often about the little girl I used to be, the one who just needed someone to say, "I see you. That makes sense."

That's what I'm trying to offer my children now.

Because when we change how we respond to feelings, we don't just change behavior in the moment – we change the story our children tell themselves about who they are allowed to be. And maybe that's what this work really is: Learning to speak to our children in the way we once needed to be spoken to ourselves.
