

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Sept. 26, to Sunday, Oct. 2, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 193 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Sept. 26

- **1900 block of Mount Hope Road, accident hit-run** – Caller to 911 reported a black Jeep stuck their vehicle and left the scene. Patrols responded; one taken into custody for aggravated unlicensed operation. Appearance ticket issued for Lewiston Town Court.
- **Williams/Swann roads, check welfare** – Caller to 911 reported a female was outside screaming at herself. Subject has mental health history. Patrols spoke with subject; female in question said she was blowing off some steam. Patrol advised her to go back inside her house.
