

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Nov. 14, to Sunday, Nov. 20, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 151 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Nov. 14

- **900 block of Mohawk Street, domestic disturbance** – Patrols on location for a 911 call.
- **5300 block of Hewitt Parkway, fire** – Caller to 911 reported a possible fire from a sewer. Heavy smoke seen by a third party. Patrol spoke with parties on scene; testing being done on sewer.
- **300 block of Niagara Street, assist** – Residential fire alarm reported by alarm provider.
- **800 block of Center Street, disturbance, non-domestic** – Caller to 911, listed as the manager at a business reported customer threatened to kill him after being asked to leave premises for being rude. Subject took off in a red Dodge Ram, travelling west on Center Street.
