

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Dec. 11, to Sunday, Dec. 17 as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. Patrols responded to 222 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, Dec. 11

- **2200 block of Saunders Settlement Road, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported three males hanging around the air pump station at a business and refusing to leave; subjects throwing cigar butts around. Patrols responded; juveniles GOA. Area checked with negative results.
