

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Dec. 5, to Sunday, Dec. 11, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 162 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Dec. 5

- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported a combative patient in the ER. Patrol responded and advised the male that he needed to leave the property. Subject complied and left.
- **600 block of Chicora Drive, death** – Patrols responded to a 911 call at the residence. Report taken.
- **900 block of Center Street, MVA property damage** – Caller to 911 reported a two-vehicle accident; no injuries. Patrol on location, report taken.
- **700 block of Center Street, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 said she received a call ordering her to take all the money from the business cash register, put it in a bag and take it to a nearby pharmacy business. Caller stated the phone call came from the business owner's own phone and the subject identified himself as a police officer.
