

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Nov. 28, to Sunday, Dec. 4, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 151 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Nov. 28

- **2900 block of Saunders Settlement Road, alarm burglary** – Alarm company reported a motion alarm triggered in the stockroom of a business. Patrols found all safe and secure.
- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, disturbance-non-domestic** – Caller to 911 reported an irate male in the ER lobby. Patrols responded; male provided a courtesy transport.
