

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, March 6, to Sunday, March 12, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 199 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, March 6

- **4200 block of Wolf Run, alarm burglary** – Call by alarm provider; patrols on location.
