NCSO update on Starpoint investigation

The Niagara County Sheriff's Office provided an update this week into its ongoing investigations involving members of the Starpoint School District wrestling team.

According to the NCSO release, "On Feb 3, 2023, the Niagara County Sheriff's Office fielded an official complaint involving allegations that occurred with the Starpoint School District wrestling team. These incidents were alleged to have happened in January 2023

"After a thorough investigation by the Sheriff's Office criminal investigation bureau, two 17-year-old juvenile Starpoint students were each charged with one count of harassment (second degree) from an incident, which occurred at a private residence on Townline Road in the Town of Wheatfield. Additionally, further harassment (second degree) charges are pending for the same two juvenile students in the Town of Pendleton stemming from allegations, which occurred on the Starpoint School District property.

"The names of the juveniles involved will not be released, due to their ages. Starpoint School District cooperated fully with the investigation. No further information will be released."
