## Deadline approaching for Lewiston Art Festival artist and vendor applications

Since 1966, the Lewiston Art Festival has attracted visitors and art lovers from Western New York and Southern Ontario, as well as international visitors from Niagara Falls. Each year, this juried art show brings 25,000 visitors to the heart of the picturesque and historic Village of Lewiston.

Organizers said, "The work of exceptional artists is showcased in a wide range of both fine and fine craft categories. Cash and ribbon prizes are awarded to art-

ists in seven categories (painting, graphic arts, mixed media, photography, ceramics, jewelry, fiber/metal/wood), plus Best Booth Display and Best of Show."

This year the Lewiston Art Festival will be held Aug. 12-13. Applications for all artists and vendors are done entirely online through Zapplication (ZAPP). ## Old Falls Street USA rebrands under Destination Niagara USA

Old Falls Street USA has rebranded to more closely mirror the brand of Destination Niagara USA, the official destination marketing organization for Niagara County.

In January of 2022, Destination Niagara USA took over management of the three-block entertainment district in downtown Niagara Falls, along with the Niagara Falls Convention Center.

"We have seen great success in the rebranding of the Niagara Falls Convention Center, as the facility operated in the black last year for the first time since it opened in 2004. Our team is confident that efforts to create a consistent sense of place and tie-in branding for Old Falls Street will yield positive results as well," said John Percy, president and CEO of Destination Niagara USA.
