

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, April 3, to Sunday, April 9, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 259 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, April 3

- **800 block of Oriole lane, noise complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a neighbor was being loud and playing music in the early morning hours. Patrols responded.
- **4000 block of Creek Road, LPD station, forgery** – Walk-in male complainant reported receiving a fake email from PayPal that claimed a hacker made a purchase through his account. Caller stated the email resulted in him sending \$3,400 in gift cards to an unknown person to stop the hacker. Patrol said the complaint proved to be fraud. Report taken.
- **4700 block of Porter Center Road, suspicious activity** – Patrols responded to a phone complaint.
- **800 block of Center Street, check welfare** – Caller to 911 stated she was worried that something happened to workers at a business. Caller said the store was open but the lights were off. Patrols responded and found a worker was using the restroom.
- **4700 block of Wolf Run, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported video footage of males wandering through yards; area checks requested. Patrol responded; report taken.
- **Ridge/Creek roads, vehicle/traffic stop** – Caller officer initiated. Patrol reported the male operator of vehicle was very confrontational upon contact. Driver demanded that patrol remove its spotlight and flashlight from his eyes when approaching the vehicle. The driver also demanded that patrol advise him of his violation before he produced his license and registration. Both
