

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, April 10, to Sunday, April 16, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 190 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, April 10
