

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 5, to Sunday, June 11, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 190 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, June 5

- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, disturbance non-domestic** – Caller to 911 reported a male outside who was irate, picking up rocks and throwing same. Responding patrols said the male was compliant and waiting for a taxicab. All OK.
