

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 12, to Sunday, June 19, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 227 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, June 12

- **3900 block of Lockport Olcott Road, burglary** – 911 call by provider; patrol responded, report taken.
- **Lower Mountain/Black Nose Springs roads, suspicious activity** – 911 call by Niagara County Parks reported a vehicle in location for more than a week. Parties interviewed by officers; subjects camping and travelling. Patrol reported all OK.

Patrol said the resident also complained to the town supervisor and attorney as well as SPCA. Caller advised to document all incidents to not communicate with
