

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 19, to Sunday, June 26, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 187 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, June 19

- **300 block of Oneida Street, ordinance violation** – Caller to 911 reported an unknown party setting off fireworks in the driveway. Caller inquired it was OK to dispose of the fireworks in the garage.
