

The following activity occurred Monday, July 10, to Sunday, July 16, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 242 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, July 10

- **Townline/Albright roads, fire** – caller to 911 reported a large fire in the woods. Patrol said a controlled burn that is almost extinguished.
