

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Thursday, Sept. 7, to Wednesday, Sept. 13, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Thursday, Sept. 7

- **Lewiston Queenston Bridge, Plaza Building 1, forgery** – Caller to 911 stated a party was requesting a cash app transfer from an onsite cash register to a private bank account. Transaction not completed; party transferred cash from a personal account. Report taken.

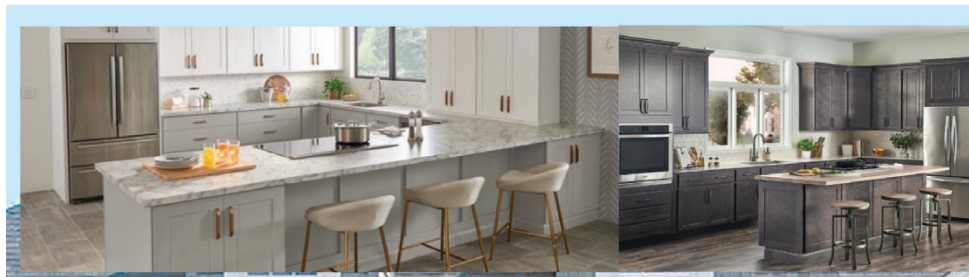
