



How to Build Your Own Fairy House

A fairy house is a great way for children to explore nature and use their imagination to create their own whimsical world!

Fairy houses are small structures built from sticks, dry grasses, leaves, pinecones and other naturally found materials. The simple challenge of creating a fairy house connects children with nature and encourages respect for the environment

While creating your own fairy house, please keep the following guidelines in mind.

- Fairies use all-natural materials to build their houses. Some of the materials they use are dry grasses, leaves, sticks, pebbles, shells, bark off a fallen tree, milkweed pods, acorns and pinecones.
- Be careful not to use or disturb any of nature's materials that are still living, especially flowers, ferns and mosses. Fairies do not like to disturb or destroy anything that is living in nature.
- Many fairy houses look so natural that they are almost hidden. So try and find somewhere quite in nature to place your fairy house, like under a tree or even in your garden.
- Have fun building them everywhere, in every season, and enjoy all of your special fairy visitors!
