

Big move for 'Little Blue House'

The Piper Law Office, also known as the "Little Blue House," was fastened, fortified, placed on a giant remote-control roller, and transported across Center Street this week.

The top two photos, taken Tuesday, show the building lifted out of the ground.

In the middle row, a crowd of two-dozen people came out at 6:30 a.m. on Thursday to watch the structure's journey to Academy Park. It took Wolfe House & Building Movers about a half-hour to wheel the home from the north side of the street to the south side. Work was supervised by Valery Contracting and Village of Lewiston Engineer Mike Marino.

The "Little Blue House" now rests at the corner of Ninth and Center streets. Fittingly, the future home of a tourist greeting center is situated next to the "Welcome to Historic Lewiston" sign. (photos by Joshua Maloni and Sue Campbell)
