I write today to invite you to join me in a meeting with Governor Cuomo and his top staff to discuss the dispute between the State and Seneca Nation and the impact it is having on Niagara Falls. The purpose would be to discuss both any potential short term relief for Niagara Falls as well as how to safeguard the money that the city is rightfully owed.

As you know, I have tried to mediate on this issue several times from my position in the Senate and though at times I thought we were on the cusp of an agreement, that simply has not happened.
