

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, March 21, to Sunday, March 27, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 188 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, March 21

- **800 block of Foxwood Drive, harassment** – Caller to 911 reported a neighbor was on the front lawn of the residence staring at her; ongoing issue. Patrols on location; report taken.
- **5800 block of Chew Road, domestic disturbance** – Patrols on location for a 911 call; No further information; report taken.
- **900 block of Center Street, assist public** – Caller to 911 relayed information to patrols regarding a conversation he overheard about drugs. No further information provided.
