

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, April 4, to Sunday, April 10, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 277 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday April 4

- **400 block of Center Street, alarm/burglary** – Patrol responded to a basement motion burglary alarm. All secure.
