

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, April 18, to Sunday, April 24, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 214 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, April 18

- **Location not listed, criminal investigation** – Patrols on scene for telephone complaint; no further information. Report taken.
- **2900 block of Saunders Settlement Road, alarm burglary** – Phone response by patrol for an unidentified general burglary alarm at a pharmacy.
