

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, March 28, to Sunday, April 3, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 198 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Patrol arrived and observed no individuals in said vehicle. Patrol added no signs of any activity were found around the vehicle due to undisturbed snowfall.
