

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Saturday, July 31, to Thursday, Aug. 5, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Saturday, July 31

- **300 block of N. Ninth Street, suspicious activity** – Caller reported a suspicious male had knocked on the door. Patrol found the subject, listed as young male in his 20s from Minnesota who was in the area offering reading services for children; male has a permit.
- **900 block of Center Street, MVA-property damage** – Caller to 911 reported a two-vehicle property damage only accident; minor damages. Information was exchanged and the other party from Pennsylvania had left. Female driver upset on having accurate information for the insurance company. Patrol handled.
- **Locations on the 500 block of Mountain View Drive; N. Ninth/Mohawk streets; N. Eighth/Mohawk streets; Ridge/Model City roads and Lewiston Road/Kenneth Avenue, vehicle/traffic stops** – All calls officer initiated. Violations per stop included: rightful owner cited for no child restraint device, front seat, under age 4; rightful owner, failure to obey traffic control device, stop sign; rightful owner, failure to stop at a stop sign; driver, unlicensed operator and failure to obey a traffic control device; and rightful owner, speed not reasonable or prudent. Uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court.
- **1100 block of Saunders Settlement Road, traffic complaint** – Female caller to 911 reported her husband who was intoxicated had just left driving a black Dodge Ram 2500; plate information unknown.
- **Saunders Settlement Road/Buffalo Street, vehicle/traffic stop** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported one suspect in custody for driving while intoxicated, with three children in vehicle. Chemical

breath testing conducted, BAC result, .22 of 1%.

Sunday, Aug. 1

- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, disturbance non-domestic** – Per a 911 call, EMS responders brought a patient into ER; subject now screaming at the staff. Staff requests the subject removed; no reason to remain on site. No weapons found; subject possibly intoxicated.
- **800 block of Oriole Lane, assist public** – Per a 911 call, a taxi driver dropped off a fare at the address and was not paid. Female party just walked into her apartment.
- **2100 block of Mount Hope Road, harassment** – Caller to 911 reported a male who harassed her earlier had drove by the residence and gave her the finger. Patrol spoke with both parties; situation resolved.

Monday, Aug. 2

- **900 block of Oxbow Lane, assist public** – Officer initiated call. Neighbor dispute reported. Patrol spoke with a female who stated her next-door male neighbor keeps entering her backyard when she is not at home to look around the new deck she just built. Complaint an ongoing issue; female requested patrol advise the male he is no longer welcomed or allowed onto her property. Male advised by patrol with threat of arrest if he re-enters property in future. Subject responded he understood and would have no further issues. Patrol cleared.
- **4900 block of Townline Road, MVA-property damage** – Caller to 911 said his vehicle lost a tire while he was driving it; subject roadside. Responding patrol said the tire was found to be missing off a trailer and not an accident.
- **N. Fourth/Center streets, MVA-property damage** – Caller to 911 reported a vehicle struck hers and left the scene; vehicle currently parked down the roadway. Responding patrol said no hit-run had occurred; the driver was moving his vehicle off the traffic lane.

- **2400 block of Moore Road, animal complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a brown dog roaming the area; caller walking her blind dog and didn't the animal to get too close. Patrol responded; call handled.
- **800 block of Oriole Lane, assist public** – Caller to 911 reported an elderly neighbor head lots of screaming and items being crashed nearby. Ongoing issue of domestics reported; no further information.
- **1100 block of Saunders Settlement Road, assist public** – Caller to 911 reported her aunt was screaming at her and ran over items with a van. Intoxicated subject left in a maroon Dodge van; unsure on direction.
- **400 block of Center Street, overdose** – Caller to 911 reported a female, 20s vomiting in front of a bar/restaurant and unable to answer questions of passerby. Subject intoxicated.
- **Locations on Creek Road/Cayuga Drive; Lewiston/Creek roads; N. Seventh/Center streets; Witmer Road/Campus Parkway; Portage Road/**

Center Street; 500 block of Mountain View Drive; and 1100 block of Ridge Road, vehicle/traffic stops – All calls officer initiated. Violations per stop included: driver cited for texting while driving, failure to keep right and failure to yield to an emergency vehicle; driver, texting; driver, texting; rightful owner, failure to obey a traffic control device; rightful owner, failure to stop at a stop sign and failure to notify DMV of change of address; driver, moving from lane unsafely, failure to obey a traffic control device and operating out of class; and driver, moved from lane unsafely. Uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court.

Wednesday, Aug. 4

- **200 block of Glenvale Road, assist** – Caller to 911 reported her 16-year-old son was being aggressive and confrontational; subject throwing things. Negative on intoxication.
- **Lewiston Queenston Bridge, assist** – Caller reported a male from Maine with a firearm in his possession. Male had returned from Canada and was turned around at Canada Border Service/Customs. Upon re-entry into the U.S. male went for secondary inspection and declared a handgun in an enclosed trailer and a Glock 42 .380 caliber. Patrol said the subject had no paperwork for the weapon and it was seized for a transfer with the FFL. Report taken.
- **Bridgeman/Upper Mountain roads, accident hit-run** – Caller to 911 reported a gold Chevy Malibu had spun out on Bridgeman Road, struck a mailbox and fled the area.
- **400 block of Plain Street, disturbance non domestic** – Caller reported a landlord-tenant dispute; the landlord sought to make contact with the tenant regarding service work and needed to access an apartment. Caller said the tenant was not cooperative recently and refused to answer the door; service company scheduled to return. Patrol advised the tenant to

cooperate; patrol cleared.

- **100 block of Swain Road, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported a suspicious four-door sedan parked on the dead end of the street for a few hours; lights on and caller suspects occupants are inside. Vehicle GOA; caller has seen vehicle parked on multiple occasions; license plate number provided.
- **1600 block of Saunders Settlement Road, assist public** – Caller to 911 reported his vehicle was stolen by his wife; caller said the female was off with another male to an unknown location. The male left on a motorcycle heading westbound on Route 31 per a family member on scene and is reportedly intoxicated.
- **700 block of The Circle Drive, criminal investigation** – Caller to 911 reported her ex-boyfriend in the driveway was in violation an order of protection. Responding patrols found the male with his hands out of the window of a Chevy Impala on the 1300 block of Upper Mountain Road; vehicle not owned by the driver. Report taken.
