NCCC selected for FAA training program

Niagara County Community College announced the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) selected its drone operator training program for the unmanned aircraft systems-collegiate training program (UAS-CTI).

“Offering coveted FAA-accredited drone operator training represents a significant step forward in our campus workforce training initiatives. Through this new partnership, the program will be taken to new heights as participants graduate with industry-recognized credentialing embodying the gold-standard in unmanned aviation of tomorrow,” said Karen Kwandrans, Ed.D. AVP, workforce development.

The FAA's UAS-CTI program recognizes institutions that prepare students for careers in unmanned aircraft systems (UAS),

commonly referred to as drones. To qualify for the initiative, schools must offer a bachelor's or associate degree in UAS or a degree with a minor, concentration or certificate in UAS. Schools must provide curriculum covering various aspects of UAS training, including hands-on flight practice, maintenance, uses, applications, privacy concerns, safety, and federal policies concerning UAS.

“Partnering with FAA in unmanned aircraft systems represents the latest in an ongoing effort to position the college at the forefront in aerospace education. We are pleased to be a sole center of excellence in providing this credential for nearly the entire northeastern United States,” said William Murabito, Ph.D., president of Niagara County Community College.

are prepared to make accommodations for medically fragile students around this requirement, but we will need very specific medical documentation to make that accommodation. Students who refuse to wear a mask will not be allowed to attend school in the In-person hybrid model. Please use this time to prepare children returning to school in-person for this requirement.

Information and preparation are the antidote for anxiety, and we hope every child and every family feels well-informed and ready to return to school. Need more information? The complete district reopening plan is on the Lew-Port website, www.lew-port.com, along with easy-to-read FAQ and learning models explained documents. Each building has an updated handbook with everything that

families need to know about the upcoming school year. Safety protocols, transportation guidelines (including pick-up/drop-off procedures), lunch and student nutrition information are all included. These handbooks are posted directly to each homepage.

Also, on the webpage you will find recordings of each family forum with the full presentation on reopening and Q&A period from the six events. New students can

watch recordings of orientations for each school, posted to their websites.
