

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Wednesday, Aug. 10, to Sunday, Aug. 16, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 245 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Aug. 10

- **5800 block of Hoover Road, suspicious activity** – Caller reported observing a female taking items out of the mailbox. Activity has occurred on three different occasions.
- **5800 block of Griffin Street, assist public** – Caller reported that a drone flew over her residence the prior day. Complainant unsure if said drone was in the area now and wishes to speak to patrol on the issue.
