

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Dec. 13, to Sunday, Dec. 19, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 184 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, Dec. 13

- **1600 block of Saunders Settlement Road, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported a lot of activity at the residence; no further information.
- **4100 block of Creek Road, traffic complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a male at the Lew-Port campus entrance holding a sign, "unmask our kids." Caller stated the male was creating a traffic hazard, making it difficult for parents to drop kids off. Patrol on location.

scene suspects intoxication; unable to verify. Patrols on location.

- **5100 block of Garlow Road, lost/found property** – State Police reported two stolen vehicles were recovered by the power lines on the roadway across from a gas/convenience business. Plate numbers logged; vehicles to be removed. Report filed.
