

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Nov. 22, to Sunday, Nov. 28, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 160 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Nov. 22

- **N. Ninth/Oneida streets, traffic complaint** – Patrol on location in response to stop sign complaints.
- **Military/Lewiston roads, MVA-property damage** – Caller to 911 reported a vehicle struck a tree, which now down in the roadway. No injuries; vehicle off to the shoulder. Responders notified.
- **Ridge Road/Cayuga Drive, traffic complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a blue or black Chevy Silverado passed a school bus with its red lights on. Vehicle last seen heading northbound on N. Ninth Street in the village.

- **Location not listed, assault** – Patrol responded to a dispatch call involving a female juvenile; victim declined EMS assistance. Parent suspected incident occurred at Ice Rink at Academy Park.
- **800 block of Center Street,**

traffic complaint – Caller to 911 reported a female, intoxicated, had walked out without paying a bill at a bar restaurant; female left in a vehicle and nearly struck three people. Responding patrols reported the female ran out of the bar/restaurant after being asked by staff several times to pay a \$47.50 bill; photos and deposition obtained from staff. Female charged with driving while intoxicated. Bar/restaurant staff requested to pursue charges.

All calls officer initiated** – Violations per stop included: driver, speed in zone and expired registration; driver, speed in zone; driver speed in zone; and last three pullovers, drivers, failure to stop at a stop sign. - **4800 block of Townline Road, MVA-injuries** – Caller to 911 reported a two-vehicle accident; unknown on injuries and airbag deployment. Responding patrol reported all occupants are conscious and alert.
- **900 block of Upper Mountain Road, assist public** – Caller to 911 reported a cat ran off and returned with its leg stuck in a leg trap with an ID tag. Responding patrol removed said trap and returned it to the owner.
- **800 block of Center Street, disturbance, not domestic** – Caller reported a female, intoxicated, at a bar/restaurant; subject possibly still inside. Caller provided description and asked responding patrols to be discreet.
- **Location not listed, harass-**

ment – Caller to 911 reported several young juveniles approaching workers with threats that a party was on their way with a gun; other juveniles had the message. Responding patrols spoke with a male juvenile involved and his parents; negative results on any report of firearms. Report taken.

• **4100 block of Creek Road, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. One suspect in custody for aggravated unlicensed operation, third; driving with more than .08 of 1% BAC; driving while intoxicated; and driving while ability impaired drugs. Appearance tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court.

Thursday, Nov. 25

- **800 block of Foxwood Drive, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported a problem with her dogs barking; a maroon truck also parked outside the residence at midnight. Caller stated her ex had sought \$1,000 from her a few months ago and she does not feel safe with him around. Patrols responded.
- **Mount Hope/Green roads, lost/found property** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported a recovered stolen vehicle, listed as a 2004 grey Chevy Silverado was found on the south side of Mount Hope Road across from Green Road. A male, 32, reported as non-violent, depressed, possibly intoxicated and having suicidal thoughts was listed on the report. Negative reports on weapons and drugs.
- **500 block of Morgan Drive, alarm burglary** – Homeowner advises she could not disable a reported alarm and was enroute to the residence.

- **400 block of Chicora Road, alarm burglary** – Patrol reported an audible alarm; residence appears secure and contacting alarm company.

- **1500 block of Upper Mountain Road, 911 hang-up in early morning hours** – Patrol responded to an open line ping in a cemetery; vehicle observed near an out-building. Driver reported as uncooperative with patrol and kept vehicle in reverse. When approached party stated they did not call 911 and left the scene. Patrol followed vehicle; driver attempted to evade LPD by driving in circles on Tuscarora Reservation lands. Officer then initiated a stop and reported the male had his pants down to his ankles with a female passenger in vehicle. Patrols on location directed the parties to return home to Garlow Road address. Both units cleared.
- **5900 block of Kline Road, burglary** – Male caller reported a shed was broken into while he was out of town and items taken. No report; increased patrols requested.
- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital** – Caller to 911 reported a female caller in the ER with her 42-year-old daughter; subjects disruptive and refused to leave, no further information. Patrol spoke with a nursing supervisor and the patient; situation resolved. All parties agreed to terms and patrol cleared without further incident.

Patrol spoke with the subjects who said they were trying to "spread the gospel." Plate number of involved vehicle traced to a religious organization in Liverpool, New York. Patrol advised the subjects to take their activity elsewhere; party complied. Resident advised to recontact patrol if subjects returned.
