

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Feb. 7, to Sunday, Feb. 13, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 215 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Monday, Feb. 7**
- **2500 block of Saunders Settlement Road, assist public** – Officer initiated call. Patrol located a vehicle off the road that appeared to have struck a mailbox. Registered owner admitted to making a wide turn into the driveway and hitting a neighbor's mailbox. Arrangements made for damages. Patrol cleared.
 - **Monteagle Trail, accident hit-run** – Caller to 911 reported his car was struck by an unknown vehicle while he was in class. Report taken.
 - **Lewiston/Military roads, vehicle/traffic stop** – Call officer initiated. Patrol out with field sobriety testing; one uniform traffic (not specified) issued to registered owner for Lewiston Town Court.

 - **2200 block of Saunders Settlement Road, MVA-injuries** – Caller to 911 reported a two-vehicle accident; possible injuries and glass in the roadway. Patrol responded.

- **I-190/Witmer Road, vehicle/traffic stop** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported an attempted felony stop of a vehicle northbound on Niagara Scenic Parkway. Vehicle crashed at Niagara Scenic Parkway/Lake Street; driver detained. Niagara Falls Police Department have units enroute; request for vehicle tow and to detain as evidence; inquiries made on injuries.
 - **400 block of Rivermist Court, missing person** – Patrols on location for a 911 call.
 - **900 block of Pletcher Road, animal complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a large black dog running up and down the street.
 - **500 block of N. Fifth Street, assist public** – Caller to 911 stated the landlord was on location to take care of plumbing emergency and the tenant refused to let him in. Landlord stated human waste was coming out of a back pipe on the property.
 - **300 block of Oak Street, alarm burglary** – Patrol on location from a call by a security provider. Female on location listed as house sitter; patrol spoke with homeowner who verified. Patrol cleared call.
 - **4600 block of Porter Center Road, theft** – Caller reported the theft of \$1,250 in cash from a jacket; theft occurred five days earlier. Patrols on location; report only.
 - **1300 block of Ridge Road, disturbance** – non-domestic – Contact from the Lewiston Town Court reported a female out of control on premises; subject has to go to jail; no warrant involved. Court officer said the female was being a problem. Patrol responded; report taken.
 - **4600 Porter Center Road, check welfare/domestic disturbance** – Officers on scene for two 911 calls. No further details.
 - **Locations on the 900 block of Center Street and N. Ninth/Mohawk streets (two pull-overs), vehicle/traffic stops**

- **900 block of Center Street, vehicle/traffic stop** – Call officer initiated. Registered owner cited for speed in zone. Uniform traffic ticket issued for Lewiston Town Court.

Male gone on patrol's arrival; officers searched store with negative results and sought a K-9 to assist without success. Male reportedly left premises in an older Ford Escape, color gold. Patrol continued store search with negative results.
 - **Saunders Settlement/Mayflower roads, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported a male, 30, walking down the road, swinging his arms and screaming profanities. Subject heading eastbound on Saunders Settlement Road.
