

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Feb. 14, to Sunday, Feb. 20, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 219 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, Feb. 14

- **700 block of Hillview Court, traffic complaint** – LPD advised by the town Highway Department of a vehicle parked on the street during prohibited overnight hours. Registered owner cited.
- **2200 block of Sanders Settlement Road, Niagara Wheatfield School District, assist public** – Officer initiated call. Parents of student becoming irate with administration. Parents left the meeting without incident.
