

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Jan. 3, to Sunday Jan. 9, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 183 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Jan. 3
