

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Jan. 17, to Sunday, Jan. 23, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 221 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, Jan. 17

- **4800 block of Creek Road, assist public** – Female caller to 911 reported a Nissan Altima stuck in the roadway. Patrol assisted vehicle to a nearby church and dropped off the driver at home.
- **Lewiston Road/I-190, traffic complaint** – Vehicle spun out on entrance ramp, female attempting to dig her car out, road hazard reported. Patrol responded.
- **4100 block of Creek Road, animal complaint** – Caller to 911 reported an injured deer in a ditch. Animal dispatched.
